

The Gold Award – Nomination Form

The Gold Award honours a person who has made a significant contribution to Welsh life in Ontario. It was established to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Ontario Gymanfa Ganu Association's annual festival. Suggested by then president, Betty Cullingworth, the Gold Award is co-sponsored and adjudicated by four important institutions which preserve and promote Welsh culture and history in Ontario: Ontario Gymanfa Ganu Association; St. David's Society of Toronto; Ottawa Welsh Society; and Dewi Sant Welsh United Church.

The Gold Award committee is comprised of representatives from the four organizations, and the previous year's recipient. Each year, board members and members at large are asked to submit candidates for the Gold Award. The recipient is selected in March of each year, and the award is presented at the annual Ontario Welsh Festival usually held in April. Past recipients include: Meriel Simpson, Dave Pugh, Donna Morris, Alison Lawson, Betty Cullingworth, Roy Morris, Harold Woodey, Myfanwy Davies, Rev. Dr. Cerwyn Davies, Myfanwy Bajaj, and Hefina Phillips.
